Nomination fee is \$10.00 per horse per year. Each horse must be re-nominated each of the following three years to be eligible to show in the Futurity (to be shown in Halter as a three year old).

Deadline for entries: December 31, 2018 – Original nominations MUST be postmarked by December 31, 2018.

Re-nominations postmarked after December 31, 2018 MUST include a \$35.00 late fee per horse in addition to the re-nomination fee. Absolute deadline for all re-nominations is March 31, 2019.

PUREBRED and HALF-ARABIAN FUTURITY RULES

General Provisions:

Eligible horses entered in the Arabian Futurity will be shown in halter as three-year-olds. (Should the AHAF Board of Directors decide to offer classes at younger ages, no funds will be allocated from AHAF Futurity funds for these classes). Classes will be held each year at the annual AHAF Holiday Festival Horse Show. The Futurity is limited to horses foaled out of mares owned or leased by AHAF members at the time of nomination and throughout all nomination years. All classes will be judged by a qualified Arabian judge. All futurity fees must be made payable to AHAF at the time of nomination and throughout all nomination years and mailed to the Futurity Chairman with the nomination form and a copy of the dam's registration papers. Partbred Futurity rules are the same as Purebred Arabian rules, except the prize money will be awarded between the mares and gelding only.

Nomination of Dam:

Nomination of the dam is necessary for all entries in the Futurity. To nominate a dam for the Futurity, the following requirements must be met.

1. The dam must be registered with the Arabian Horse Registry of America or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry. A copy of the dam's registration certificate must be included with the nomination form. The owner or lessee must be a member of AHAF at the time of nomination and in the renomination years,
2. \$10.00 must be paid on or before (postmarked) January 1st of the year in which the foal is born.
3. No fees shall be refunded if a mare nominated does not produce a foal or if the foal dies.
4. The cost of trophies and/or prizes such as coolers, ribbons, postage and printing of certificates and nomination forms, and any cost of advertising, will be taken out of the interest generated by the Futurity fund. Any type of expense will be taken out of the Futurity funds only if necessary.

Renomination:

On or before January 1st of each succeeding year, each foal of nominated mares must be renominated by paying a \$10.00 renomination fee. A copy of the foal's registration certificate must accompany the renomination fee. No horse that is not timely renominated may thereafter be reinstated. A late fee of \$35.00, plus the \$10.00 renomination fee per horse will be accepted through March 31st for renominations only. Renomination forms will be sent to each owner of record of a nominated horse. However, it is the responsibility of the mare/foal owner to make sure that he/she has received a nomination form and if he/she did not receive a form, request a form from the Futurity Chairman.

Futurity Competition:

To make a colt, filly or gelding eligible to show in the Futurity class, the following requirements must be met:

1. The colt, filly or gelding must be three years old and must have been renominated in a timely manner in each of the prior years.
2. The show entry fee, plus all applicable fees, must be paid at the show in which the Futurity classes are to be held. \$10.00 of the entry fee shall be added to the appropriate purse for the class in which the horse will be shown.
3. Colt, fillies and geldings will be shown separately at halter.

Prize Money:

At the time the deadline for nomination of dams has passed, the entire purse for Purebred Arabians will be subdivided into three purses for colts, fillies and geldings (two for Partbred Arabian fillies and geldings). Thereafter, all renomination fees shall be placed in the appropriate purse for which the horse is eligible. Whenever the Futurity Chairman is notified that a horse has been gelded, an adjustment shall be made in the colt purse transferring funds to the gelding purse in the amount as if the horse had always been in the gelding purse.

The money in each purse shall be distributed to those horses actually shown and judged in the appropriate Futurity classes as follows:

1. Only one is shown: 75% to the Champion; 25% allocated to the following year's purse.
2. Two are shown: 60% to the Champion; 30% to the Reserve Champion; 10% allocated to the following year's purse.
3. Three are shown: 50% to the Champion; 30% to the Reserve Champion; 20% to third place.
4. Four are shown: 50% to the Champion; 25% to the Reserve Champion; 15% to third place; 10% to fourth place.
5. Five or more shown: 45% to the Champion; 25% to the Reserve Champion; 15% to third place; 10% to fourth place; 5% to fifth place.

Liability:

No entry is liable for more than the amount paid in, but there will be no return of a payment made. The right is reserved to reject any entry, and to bar any entry from competition for failure to comply with the requirements of the AHAF Futurity.

Change of Address or Sales:

It is the responsibility of the owner of a Futurity nominated horse to notify the Futurity Chairman of change of address in writing. If a nominated horse is sold, it is the responsibility of the new owner to inform the Futurity Chairman in writing of the change of ownership and the new owner's address. The new owner shall keep up all renominations and fees.

Disputes:

The AHAF Board of Directors shall be the final authority for all disputes regarding the AHAF Futurity.
